

### Workshop Sign-In



The Alumni Center is at 725 SW 26<sup>th</sup> Street, Corvallis, OR 97331 and the LaSells Stewart Center is at 875 SW 26<sup>th</sup> Street, Corvallis, OR 97331. Sign-in will be Friday, Jan. 27 from 7:30 a.m. – 8:15 a.m. at the Alumni Center, Room 115.

Driving Directions from I-5 north or south – Leave Hwy I-5 at exit 228 (Corvallis/OSU). Take Hwy 34 WEST (right turn if you're driving south; left turn for those driving north) and continue approximately 10 miles. Make a left turn onto Hwy 34 bypass. Continue onto US-20 W. Turn right onto SW 26<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn right onto SW Western Blvd. The hotel will be on the right, 2500 SW Western Blvd., Corvallis, OR 97333.




