

Motel Accommodations



Workshop Sign-In



Take Hwy 34 WEST (right turn if you're driving south; left turn for those driving north) and continue approximately 10 miles. Make a left turn onto Hwy 34 bypass. Continue onto US-20 W. Turn right onto SW 26th Street. Turn right onto SW Western Blvd. The hotel will be on the right, 2500 SW Western Blvd., Corvallis, OR 97333.




